Multilingual and Multicultural Learning in Early Years Education

The conference will take place on **31st of May** at the Faculty of Education, Kardeljeva pl. 16, 1000 Ljubljana, Slovenia, with the start at 9:00.

Our speakers are coming from Sweden (Madline Arbid), United Kingdom (Jade Pollard, PhD and Rachel Till), Greece (Nadia Vlahoutsou, Cristina Taka) and Czech Republic (Egle Havrdova, PhD). They are all teachers, early years teachers or experts in the field of early yearteaching and will present the systems of early years education.

The presentations will focus on the following topics:

- Provide information about early years (kindergarten and preschool education from the countries of Czech, England, Sweden and Greece) (policies and practice)
- How to ensure that the learning environment is stimulating and challenging for children from all backgrounds
- How to celebrate a child's academic and personal achievements from different backgrounds together with parents
- develop a positive attitude to one another, regardless of gender, race, culture, belief, values, age and need.
- How to encourage parents to become active members within our community of the setting and help them to see that they can make an impact of the world around them.

The conference will provide delegates with an opportunity to engage in challenging and critical reflection, covering a wide range of case studies. It will last from 9:00 to 15:00.

The event will be also the opportunity to exchange information and experiences with other child care professionals and teachers. We expect 25 childcare professionals from the United Kingdom and Czech Republic.

The event is free of charge.
